

PEPTIDE DSIP



Description:

DSIP stands for Delta Sleep-Inducing Peptide. It is a neuropeptide, meaning it's a small protein-like molecule used by neurons to communicate with each other. DSIP is found in various parts of the brain and has been implicated in several biological functions, particularly in the regulation of sleep.

Benefits:

Promotes deeper, more restful sleep while supporting relaxation and healthy sleep patterns.



Side Effects:

It is important that you follow the dose and administration instructions as listed. DSIP is generally well tolerated. Some may experience mild drowsiness, dizziness, headaches, or vivid dreams as sleep patterns adjust. Less commonly, nausea or daytime grogginess may occur. If any of these symptoms become severe, contact us and let the medical team know.

PM (about 60-90 minutes before bed)



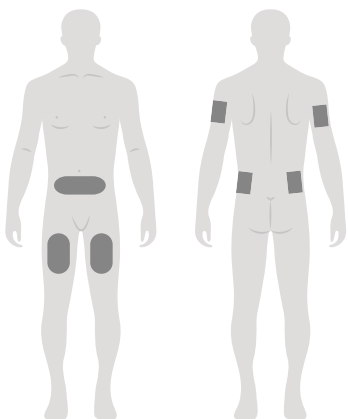
Take Daily



Inject 10 units, SQ



Refrigerate



Injection Site:

Use an alcohol swab on the top of the vial and at the site of injection before use. Work in a clockwise fashion around the belly button to ensure the prior injection sites have healed, avoiding tender areas. Other subcutaneous area shown to the left.



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
