

PEPTIDE SEMAGLUTIDE



Description:

Semaglutide is a peptide used to help people lose weight and manage their blood sugar levels. It works by mimicking a hormone in your body called GLP-1, which helps regulate your appetite and control your blood sugar. By mimicking this hormone, semaglutide can make you feel less hungry and more satisfied after eating, stopping you from over-indulging.



Each round should be maintained for at least 4 weeks (if the benefits are sustained past 4 weeks, then it is best to maintain the lowest effective dose). Start w/ a micro-dose: Inject 15 units - Next Step: Inject 25 units - Next Step: Inject 50 units - Next Step: Inject 75 units - Peak maintenance dose: Inject 100 units. Taper to be determined in consideration of your length of time to achieve your goal. Dose will be stepped down every 2-3 weeks until you are completely off of the medication

Side Effects:

It is important that you follow the dose and administration instructions as listed. You may experience mild nausea, indigestion, or constipation are common, especially when starting treatment. Some may also experience bloating or injection site irritation. These effects usually improve over time. If any of these symptoms become severe or you feel like your current dose is not effective, contact us and let the medical team know.

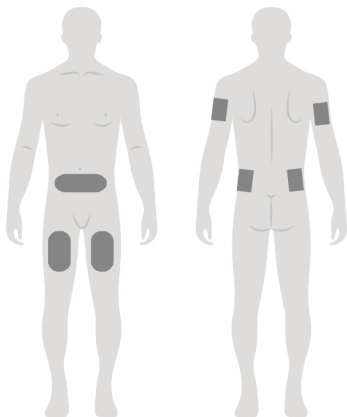

Injection Site:

Use an alcohol swab on the top of the vial and at the site of injection before use. Work in a clockwise fashion around the belly button to ensure the prior injection sites have healed, avoiding tender areas. Other subcutaneous area shown to the left.
